#### STUDENT'S ALMANAC:-

#### **TIFFIN POLICY:-**


- Ensure to send two tiffins one for seasonal fruits and one for lunch (home-cooked food only).
- Ensure to follow the given Food Menu which is curated under the guidance of a certified dietician. It aims to ensure a wholesome, balanced diet and to help children develop healthy eating habits by including a variety of vegetables and pulses.
- Include a seasonal fruit with appropriate child friendly cutlery.
- Tiffins will not be accepted during school hours once the day has begun.

# **School Holidays:-**

- Every last Saturday will be off.
- Summer Vacation: 1<sup>st</sup> June,2025 to 2<sup>nd</sup> July,2025. School will reopen on 3<sup>rd</sup> July,2025
   at usual school timings.

# **BIRTHDAY POLICY:-**

- Students must come in regular school uniform.
- Only one Candy of good quality is allowed for distribution (No gifts, treats or party wear/ Casual dress is allowed).
  - Big packets, if sent for distribution, will be returned.





- Daily send one chopped seasonal fruit in a separate box for fruit break.
- Maggi is not allowed in school tiffin.
- Foil paper is not allowed. Pack Chapatti in fresh cloth napkin.



# **SCHOOL BAG:-**

- Supervise / help your child while packing his / her bag to ensure that he / she carries books & notebooks according to the time table only.
- Carrying valuables, electronic watches / devices and objectionable articles in bag are strictly banned in the school and if found, will be confiscated.
- School bag should be washed periodically.



# **LEAVE GUIDELINES:-**

- Apply for casual leave through the ERP or Almanac.
- Long/medical leave requires a written request with supporting documents.
- Half-day or short leave is not permitted.
- During assessments, only medical leave with proper certification will be accepted.

# PARENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM:-

- PTMs are scheduled for the second Saturday of each month (except public holidays).
- It is mandatory for all the parents to attend PTM
